4. ELECTRONIC VISA

General Information:

- As of August 15, 2023, foreign travellers from all countries holding a **valid national passport** are eligible to apply for an electronic visa (evisa) for Vietnam.
- Legal basis: Law No. 23/2023/QH15 passed by the National Assembly of Vietnam and Resolution No. 127/NQ-CP issued by the Government of Vietnam.
- Applicants are not automatically entitled to a visa for Vietnam. Visa denials do not require justification.
- During the e-visa application process, the following technical issues may occur: payment failure, inability to upload passport photos, incomplete data submission, etc. These problems may be due to system overload. It is recommended to cancel the application and try again after a few days.
- Due to high demand, the standard three-day processing time for e-visa applications cannot always be guaranteed. Travelers are advised to apply as early as possible.
- Please note: The Embassy of Vietnam is not responsible for issuing evisas and cannot provide support with the e-visa application process or offer information regarding its status. Intervention by the embassy in e-visa matters is not possible.
